












Purpose of this Document




To provide participating start-up teams, talents and coordinators a step by step overview into the goals, deliverables and planning of the Start For Future (SFF) Match & Start Programme.



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


We employ the Start For Future innovation process with the following objectives:

Empowering students to think entrepreneurially

Develop innovative solutions to current global challenges in line with UN SDGs

Development of new B2B co-creation projects & business models for the transformation of economies

During the Match & Start SPRINT Programme,



Enlarged and newly formed international teams work on their concepts and develop prototypes, which could be further developed into real businesses.

Input and various feedback sessions are provided by industry experts, business coaches as well as relevant startups and industry partners. Business concepts of international teams are matched with the most suitable incubators in the partner network for further support in development, incubation (virtual and physical) and market entry.



Start For Future

Match & Start phase



Talents, teams and start-ups who are selected for the Match & Start phase through the open call applications & phase 1 selections, jointly enter this phase 2, wherein:

Teams and start-ups can find new team members

Talents can find other talents and create their own teams

Finalized teams are matched with sparring partners

Teams are matched with SFF incubators for subsequent incubation, including 750 Euros of Prototyping funding

Teams should be pitch ready for the Start For Future Final Pitch Day in which all teams present in front of a judges panel

ROLES

As a team or talent, you will interact with Start For Future team members, fulfilling the following roles. Each of these roles contribute to your entrepreneurial progress in a specific area

Business Sparring Partner


Each team will get one experienced entrepreneur to be available for weekly check-ins and to guide the general business development of the team and their idea

Industry Experts

Alongside the sparring business partner, each team will be matched with an industry expert coming from a regional ecosystem or industry partner from SFF or from EIT (European Institute of Innovation and Technology). This expert can provide more technical insight into specific vertical industry segments


Mentors

Individual talents are matched with SFF mentors to coach them in preparation for the Team Formation Dating session – when they have to choose or create a team



TOPICS

Manufacturing



Team Formation



In order to form and reinforce teams, two weeks are reserved for Team formation, consisting of the following core activities:

Kick-off event

04.02.2023 - 13-16 CET

Existing teams, start-ups as well as individual talents pitch their ideas or skillset and receive the curriculum for the entire phase

Talents "apply" to join existing teams or form their own team with like minded individuals

Teams have 1-on-1's with the applicants and decide to extend their team

Cut off Date February 26th

Each talent and team has a 1-on-1 session with a Start For Future coordinator to discuss status & advance into the 2nd phase

Talents without a team will be released from the Programme

Phase 3 Develop & Co-create

International Open Incubator

Graduated teams of Match & Start can audition to join one (or more) of our 16 international incubators from all over Europe. The chosen incubators will support your team for the duration of the Develop & Co-create Programme (6 months, April – October) in their local ecosystem, with the goal to get your team and concept market ready.

Some incubators offer coaching & on demand support, others fully fletched virtual or physical programmes. You can also ask for Coincubation, and receive support from multiple incubators at once.

Make sure to audition for the ones that fits your start-up goals and target market best!

Explore the European Market

Selected teams in the Develop & Co-create programme enjoy the below benefits:

- A €750 prototype voucher, paid by the chosen Incubator
- 3 Inspirational Sessions on advanced start-up techniques:
 - Co-creation with Industry
 - Financing & Funding in the SFF network
 - Follow-up Opportunities & Programmes
- A chance to win a Mobility Voucher worth €2500. This money can be spent on a 1-2 week trip to explore other incubators, markets & meet new customers or partners.



Co-creation @ the SFF Summit

Advanced teams can participate in our B2B Matching and Co-creation event – the Start For Future Summit at the end of 2023.

This is an international event with industry partners from all over the Start For Future network. It's focus is on finding potential partners, customers, and landing pilot projects.

An Open call for Co-creation will be published mid of July 2023.

Jury panel: people outside the Start For Future community (business angels, industry partners, EIT, ...)














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
